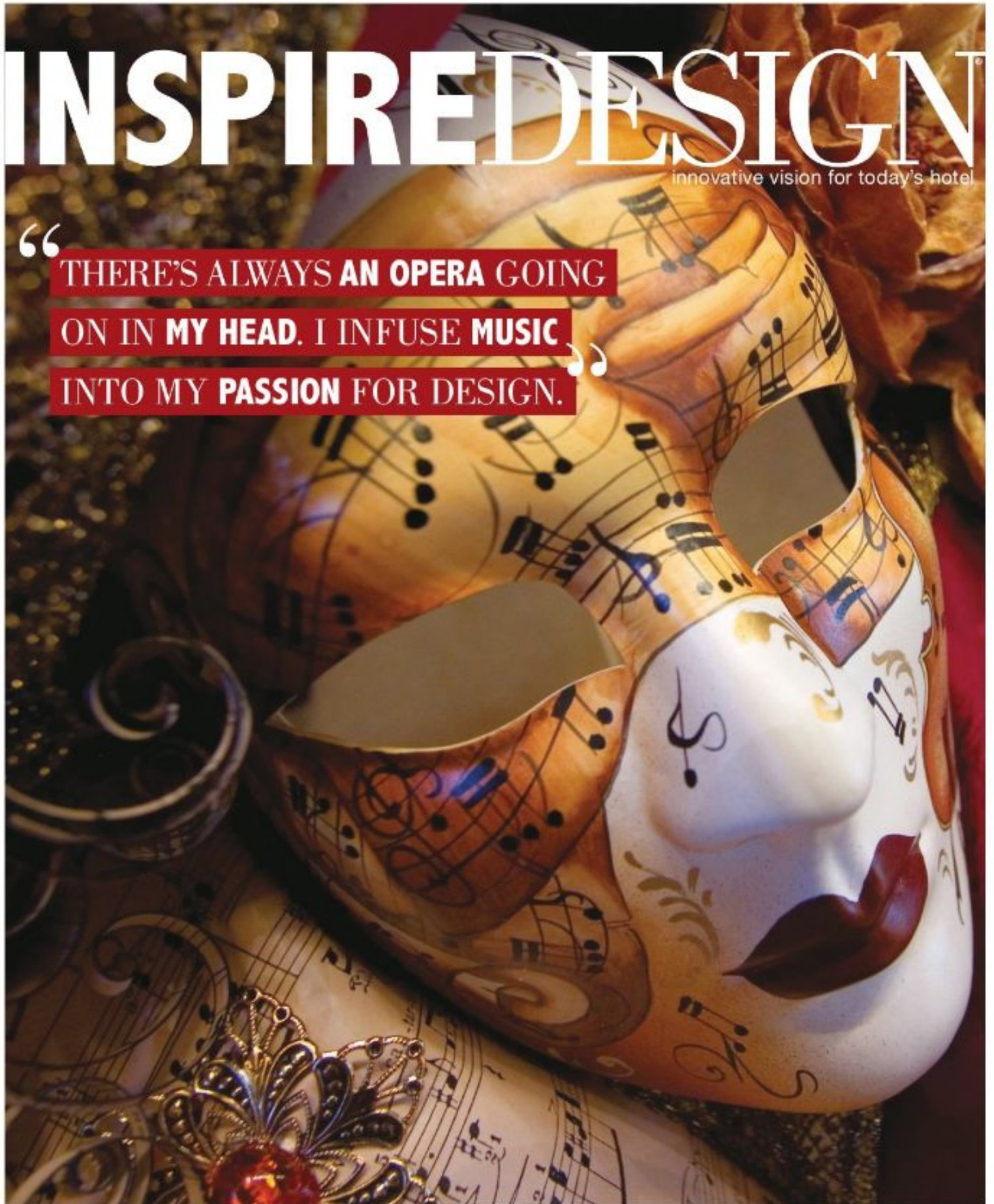

Selected for its “animating and life-affirming” hue, Pantone’s Color of the Year is Living Coral (16-1546). From lighting to furniture, this peachy-keen shade is ready to brighten spaces as an accent or big splash. Here are ways to add pops of coral to your interiors.
